- Current Grade in each class

- Descriptions and Due Dates for upcoming assignments
- Attendance Information and Statistics for each day
- Configure Email Alerts on grades and attendance
- Transcript Information

Gradelink is supported on Internet Explorer 6.0 or higher (Windows XP includes Internet Explorer 6.0 by default) and current versions of Safari and Firefox. If you need to verify your browser version you can do this by starting Internet Explorer, clicking the 'Help' menu and selecting 'About Internet Explorer'.
